



## Whose Job is it Anyway?

**Supervisor:** One who Unsures that teachers meet the requirements of their positions at a satisfactory level and continue to do so over time.

**Coach:** One who helps teachers to recognize what they know and can do, assists teachers as they strengthen their ability to make more effective use of what they know and do, and supports teachers as they learn more and do more.
